## **Vinyl Siding**

## Visual Inspection for Homeowners

Start doing a full walk around the house, inspecting from ground level to the roof. Note the overall condition and look for any obvious issues before focusing in on specific areas.

General Condition of Panels Missing, loose, rattling or pulling away from the wall Cracked, chipped or damaged Warping, buckling or bulging (especially near areas of sun exposure) Proper overlap (no large gaps)
Check Color & Appearance Uneven or significant color fading Spray marks or sap from trees, grills, insecticides or lawn equipment
Inspect Openings Ensure flashing is present and properly installed around windows & doors
Signs of Moisture Damage Mold, mildew or algae growth (green/dark stains) Water streaks beneath seams, windows or trim Soft spots or discoloration
Caulking & Sealant Cracking or peeling of caulking around windows, doors & trim Seams and joints at-risk of water intrusion, improperly sealed
Fasteners & Attachments Nails or fasteners popping-out or visible where they shouldn't be Fixtures (lights, vents, outlets, hose bibs etc.) insecurely sealed to siding
Pests & Wildlife Signs of ant or pest trails on siding Visible holes, gnaw marks or nests (especially under eaves and at corners)
Ground & Landscaping Clearance Trees, shrubs or vegetation making direct contact with siding Bottom edge of siding less than 6" above ground or mulch
Gutters, Downspouts & Water Management Improper direction of water Overflow staining or rot near gutterlines
